The wing co coordinators are **DR.S.ALAGUMANIAN** Assistant professor of Botany and Dr. **PALANISAMY**, Assistant professor of Zoology. The Eco club has 25 volunteers of each wing.

2017 – 2018 academic year we have successfully conducted Dengue awareness programme on 16.02.2018 and college campus cleaning work on 18.03.2018. Our club members (50) were actively participated in the events.

In the academic year **2018 – 2019**, the Eco club activities started with an inauguration of "Special Lecture on Vermi-composting" on 12.03.19 by **Dr.A.Gandhi, Assistant Professor in Botany**, who is having excellent knowledge in Bio-compost and he has demonstrated the importance of organic farming and its need for today's polluted world scenario. Moreover, he explained the significance of vermin-compost and various types worms, the friends of farmers helping in the process of composting with a demonstration of the same.

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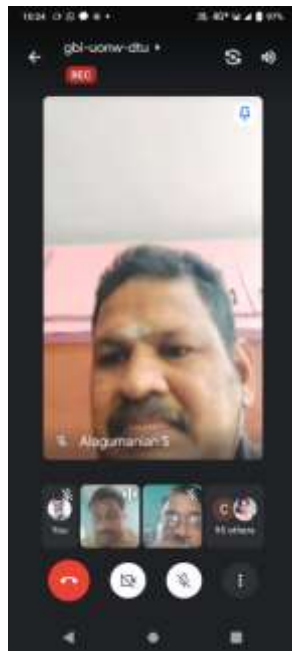
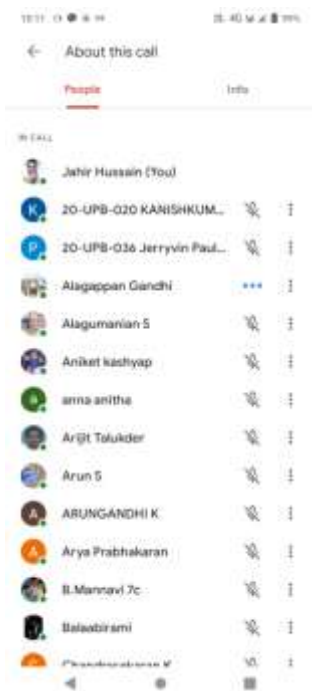
